

Pre-Kindergarten 4

The primary school program at First Baptist Academy will provide a stimulating classroom environment that allows a child to reach his/her potential in the areas of cognitive, social-emotional, spiritual, and physical development. We will provide an enriched curriculum that will be taught by a certified-degreed professional that will continually work to revise and provide age appropriate instruction and materials.

The curriculum will provide students with instruction in the following areas:

- Reading readiness
- Math instruction
- Constructive play
- Exposure to the fine arts and foreign language
- Communication skills between children
- Reason and logical thinking
- Responsibility and increased independence
- Motor skill development
- Creative exploration through centers
- Positive social interaction

Reading

Daily language arts instruction will consist of phonological awareness, reading to the children, shared reading, journal writing, and other opportunities for vocabulary development.

Mathematics

Daily instruction in the area of math will focus on number recognition and knowledge, patterns, sorting, shapes, calendar, matching one to one, and other key elements of math development and measurement.

Learning Centers

Children will work in centers that will focus on key elements of the reading, math, social studies, or science curriculum. Materials and projects are open ended and offer children the opportunity to explore, have social interaction, and express themselves in a creative manner. Center time will focus on art, blocks, books, computer, math manipulatives, writing, books, dramatic play, and science.

Art, Music, Spanish, Library, Computer, PE

The children will have weekly instruction in the areas of art, music, Spanish, library and story time, computer reading and math readiness, and Motor Skills through PE.
